The Good News

"90%" of the rule aligns with well established Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs)

- Emphasis on same 5 major potential vectors of contamination: water, animals, manure, workers, and food contact surfaces.
- Concentrates on practices, not on recordkeeping
- Farms already complying with private sector GAP standards should have little difficulty complying with the rule
